






## **Employment Status at Entry**



Total Integrated Education and Training (IET) participation reported for PY 2020 was 39,071.







## Participants in Corrections Education Longitudinal Trend




## Adult Education Program Providers




## Measurable Skill Gains – ESL Participants Five Year Trend






## Measurable Skill Gains PY 2020 by Demographic Categories






### Employment – Second Quarter PY2020 by Demographic Categories










## Median Earnings PY2020 – by Demographic Categories














### Credential Rate PY2020 by Demographic Categories










